





Encompasses the 9 counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Solano and Sonoma

Over 3,300 positions with an annual operating budget of over \$500 million

Manages 6,500 lane miles on over 770 centerline miles of conventional highways and 690 centerline miles of freeways, including 459 miles of carpool lanes

Has over \$3.4 billion and 119 capital outlay projects under construction

Operates seven toll bridges: Antioch, Benicia, Carquinez, Richmond-San Rafael, San Mateo-Hayward, San Francisco-Oakland and Dumbarton









FY 2014-2015 Construction Workload




