**SUMMARY**

This amendment delays \$750,000 in Regional Improvement Program (RIP) and \$750,000 in Interregional Improvement Program (IIP) funds programmed for construction from FY 2001-02 to FY 2003-04 for the Devil's Slide Bypass project in San Mateo County. The total project cost remains the same.

**BACKGROUND**

This amendment delays \$750,000 in Regional Improvement Program (RIP) and \$750,000 in Interregional Improvement Program (IIP) funds programmed for construction from FY 2001-02 to FY 2003-04 for the Devil’s Slide Bypass project in San Mateo County. The total project cost remains the same.

Highway closures due to landslides and roadway failures, especially during winter storms, are frequent on state Route 1 between Montara and Pacifica, also known as the “Devil’s Slide” area. Such highway closures have created a hardship to coastal residents and businesses. To eliminate this problem, the Devil’s Slide Bypass project was programmed to construct a tunnel with bridge approaches bypassing the active slide area.


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The change in the project schedule is due to a delayed Biological Opinion from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service needed to complete the Record of Decision (ROD) and finalize approval of the environmental process. The revised schedule anticipates completion of the design phase by April of 2003 with a ready to list date of July 2003. The federal funding schedule for the construction and construction support components has been modified accordingly.
