ROUTE 29 IN NAPA COUNTY

RECOMMENDATION

The Department recommends that the California Transportation Commission, as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-01-18.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Negative Declaration has been completed:


- Route 29 in Napa County– Construct an interchange at Trancas Street and Route 29 in the City of Napa.

The project is programmed in the 2000 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for construction in the 2000/01 fiscal year at \$53.5 million (\$44.9 million capital funds and \$8.6 million support funds). The current cost estimate for the project is \$54.8 million (capital and support costs). The additional funding will be obtained by selling the City of Napa and the State's excess properties and applying those funds to the construction project.

The Negative Declaration and supporting Initial Study has been transmitted to Commission staff.

The Department has approved the project for construction. This approval and the resulting filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.
