RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve Relinquishment Resolutions R-3512 - R-3513.

All superseded highways included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described by the individual summaries.

R-3512 – 6-Fre-168-KP R14.8/R19.6 (Request No. 84667) – 5 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the County of Fresno, between Temperance Avenue and Thompson Avenue, consisting of superseded highway right of way, relocated and reconstructed county roads, connecting roads, frontage roads and cul-de-sacs. The County by cooperative agreement dated December 2, 1998, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3513 – 7-Ven-126-PM 13.5 (Request No. 1103A) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the County of Ventura, at the intersection of Telegraph Road and Hallock Drive, consisting of superseded highway right of way. The 90-day notice period expired March 10, 2002, without exception.
