SUMMARY

This amendment deletes one \$250,000 Fiscal Year (FY) 1999-00 Environmental Enhancement and Mitigation (EEM) Program project for the City of Lancaster and adds one \$144,750 City of Los Angeles project to the FY 1999-00 EEM Program, adopted under Resolution G-99-20.

The City of Lancaster was unable to secure matching funds for the approved project per the attached letter and requested the project be removed from the FY 1999-00 EEM Program. The City of Los Angeles' Cultivating Communities: Phase II project is the highest ranked project in the south counties, that was not funded in the adopted FY 1999-2000 EEM Program.
