**DELEGATION OF ALLOCATION AUTHORITY**  
**LOCAL ASSISTANCE ALLOCATIONS FOR PROJECT DEVELOPMENT**  
**COMPONENTS OF LOCAL GRANT PROJECTS**  
**RESOLUTION G-99-22 ALLOCATIONS**

**BACKGROUND**

On July 15, 1999, the California Transportation Commission delegated to the Department authority to allocate funds by Resolution G-99-22 for Project Development Components of Local Grant projects. This authority allows the local agencies to begin work without waiting for the next CTC meeting to receive an allocation.

These Project Development Cost projects are included in the adopted State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The Department reports allocations on a quarterly basis consistent with Resolution G-99-22.

**SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS**

Pursuant to the authority granted by Resolution G-99-22, since the last report the Department made nine (9) separate allocations of State and Federal Funds totaling \$827,000, for nine (9) Project Development Components of Local Grant projects. A list of the nine (9) allocations is attached.
