**DELEGATION OF ALLOCATION AUTHORITY**  
**LOCAL ASSISTANCE ALLOCATIONS FOR RSTP/CMAQ**  
**MATCH RESERVE PROJECTS**  
**RESOLUTION G-98-25 ALLOCATIONS**

**BACKGROUND**

On October 28, 1998, the California Transportation Commission delegated to the Department authority to allocate funds by Resolution G-98-25 for RSTP/CMAQ Match Reserve projects. This authority allows the local agencies to begin work without waiting for the next CTC meeting to receive an allocation.

These RSTP/CMAQ Match Reserve projects are included in the adopted State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The Department reports allocations on a quarterly basis consistent with Resolution G-98-25.

**SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS**

Pursuant to the authority granted by Resolution G-98-25, since the last report the Department made 17 separate allocations totaling \$445,000, for 15 RSTP/CMAQ Match Reserve projects. A list of the 17 allocations is attached.
