SUMMARY

This amendment programs an additional \$1,500,000 from Santa Cruz County's Unprogrammed Share Balance to include slope stabilization on the Amesti Road reconstruction project in Santa Cruz County.

BACKGROUND

This amendment programs an additional \$1,500,000 from Santa Cruz County's Unprogrammed Share Balance to include slope stabilization on the Amesti Road reconstruction project in Santa Cruz County.


Amesti Road in Corralitos has been closed since 1995 due to storm damage and landslides. The 1998 El Nino storm inflicted further damage to this section of the road and caused additional slope failure. A project to reconstruct the roadway was originally programmed in the 1998 STIP in September 1999 for a total of \$620,000 under STIP Amendment 98S-047.

Since that original programming, the County has completed preliminary geotechnical studies and determined that the slope adjacent to the damaged roadway must be stabilized as well. The additional \$1,500,000 in Regional Improvement Program (RIP) funding and \$1,130,000 in local funding are now required to fund both the slope stabilization and the roadway reconstruction work, bringing the total funding to \$3,250,000. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Office of Emergency Services (OES) have indicated that they would provide the additional funding shown for the slope stabilization and for the roadway reconstruction.
