**ITEM 1.(4)**

**PROPOSED CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS:**

- 2.1a.(1) Amend STIP to delay and adjust programming for 36 projects in 19 counties, with a net change in programming of \$674,900,000. Advances \$4,711,000 of IIP funds and adds \$169,000 from Shasta County's Unprogrammed Share Balance.
- 2.1a.(2) Amend STIP to delete \$3,154,000, and reprogram \$12,683,000, in CMAQ match reserve for Contra Costa, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Solano and Sonoma. Programs 3 new projects for a total of \$2,383,000 in San Francisco and San Mateo.
- 2.1a.(3) Amend STIP to program \$6,245,000, for 10 projects, and 1 existing project, and revises 2 existing projects in Butte, El Dorado, Humboldt, Plumas, and Tehama.
- 2.1a.(4) Amend STIP to program \$2,199,000 from the unprogrammed county shares for 2 new projects in Madera and Tuolumne Counties and revise three existing projects in Fresno, San Benito and Santa Barbara Counties.
- 2.1a.(5) Amend STIP to delete \$6,071,000 in RIP/STIP funding from ten projects in Los Angeles County, replace the funding with local funds, and revise three existing projects in Los Angeles, Orange and San Diego Counties. In addition, \$30,932,000 in STIP (RIP) funds from Los Angeles County's Unprogrammed Share Balance replace Proposition C funds on the Route 30 project.
- 2.1a.(6) Amend STIP to delete \$5,932,000 for a passing lane project on Route 46 in San Luis Obispo and reprogram \$5,000,000 to a Route 46 widening project in the same location, the remaining \$932,000 reverting.
- 2.1a.(7) Amend STIP to split a programmed project on Interstate 5 in Yolo County into two phases and add additional local funding to the second phase.
- 2.1a.(8) Amend STIP to transfer a portion of the scope and \$5,250,000 in construction funds on Highway 70 widening project in Yuba County to a new Highway 70 Motorplex Interchange project. Advance \$4,800,000 from IIP to cover cost increases and designation of four current Route 70 projects as a corridor project. This amendment also programs \$4,162,000 from Yuba County's Unprogrammed Balance for two projects to construct a new interchange.
- 2.1a.(9) Amend STIP to delay the construction components of a widening project on Route 84 (Jefferson Boulevard) in West Sacramento, reduce project scope, and reduce local funding.
- 2.1a.(10) Amend STIP to combine three programmed projects on Routes 70, 99 and 149 in Butte County, and delays the combined project from FY 2000-01 to FY 2001-02.
- 2.1a.(11) Amend STIP to delete \$26,000,000 from the \$40,423,000 Marin 101 Southbound HOV Lane project and backfill with local CMAQ funds. Total cost of the project remains unchanged. Also, program \$26,000,000 from Marin County's unprogrammed share balance to the Golden Gate Bridge Seismic Retrofit Phase II project.
- 2.1a.(12) Amend STIP to reduce IIP funding for a habitat mitigation project in San Bernardino from \$9,196,000 to \$3,659,000, and advance the schedule from FY 2002-03 to FY 2000-01.
- 2.1a.(13) Amend STIP to revise the scope of Route 180 East project in Fresno County from a 4-lane freeway to a 6-lane freeway, delay the project construction and advance \$17,097,000 from the local RIP STIP to fund cost increases.
- 2.1d.(1) Amend Prop. 116 application for Modoc County to shift \$60,120 from 2 completed vehicle projects and \$55,320 in unallocated funds to the Canby Bikeway Project
- 2.1d.(2) Amend Prop. 116 application for Nevada County to shift \$18,354 from a transit project to an existing \$506,243 CNG transit vehicle project.
- 2.1d.(3) Amend Prop. 116 application for Nevada County to shift \$66,000 from a bus stop signs project to two new projects: (1) \$34,500 for a Transit Vehicle Turn-Pocket; and, (2) \$31,500 for a system-wide bus shelter program.
- 2.1d.(4) Amend Prop. 116 application for Tuolumne County to increase funding by \$231,172 for: (1) Jamestown Pedestrian Project by \$131,000; and, (2) Ferretti Road Pedestrian Project by \$100,172.
- 2.1f. Amend EEM Program to delete \$250,000 Newfield Acquisition project and add Sacramento Dry Creek Parkway Acquisition project for \$250,000.
- 2.2c Approve Negative Declaration to construct connector at Route 5/113 interchange in Woodland.
- 2.3b.(1) Approve new public road connections to Route 405 at Avenue of the Arts and at Anton Boulevard in Costa Mesa.
- 2.3b.(2) Approve new public road connection to Route 1 at Rice Avenue in Oxnard.
- 2.3b.(3) Approve new public road connection to Route 99 at The Marketplace Road in Yuba.
- 2.3c. Approve 5 Relinquishment Resolutions to turn over sections of state highways to local agencies.
- 2.4b. Approve 5 Resolutions of Necessity toward condemning properties needed for state highway purposes.
- 2.4d. Approve 4 Director's Deeds to sell excess properties no longer needed for state highway purposes for \$98,700. (\_\_\_\_\_ percent of estimated market value).

- 2.5a.** Allocate \$7,270,700 from State Highway Account funds for 18 Minor Projects.
- 2.5b.(1)** Allocate \$326,245,000 in State Highway Account funds for 28 STIP Projects.
- 2.5b.(2)** Allocate \$106,584,000 from State Highway Account funds for 20 SHOPP Projects.
- 2.5b.(4)** Allocate \$596,000 from State Highway Account funds for 2 SHOPP TEA Projects.
- 2.5c.(1)** Allocate \$44,867,000 from State Highway Account funds for 43 Local STIP Projects.
- 2.5c.(2)** Allocate \$226,000 from State Highway Account funds for 1 Local TEA Project.
- 2.5c.(3)** Allocate \$11,448,000 from State Highway Account Funds for 18 Local TEA Projects.
- 2.5c.(4)** Allocate \$5,600,000 from State Highway Account Funds for 2 Conservation Lands Projects.
- 2.6a.(1)** Allocate \$1,000,000 in State Highway Account/Public Transportation Account funds to Folsom for 1 TCI project.
- 2.6a.(2)** Allocate \$324,000 in State Highway Account/Public Transportation Account funds to the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District for 1 TCI Project.
- 2.6a.(3)** Allocate \$500,000 in State Highway Account/Public Transportation Account funds to Los Angeles for 1 TCI Program.
- 2.6a.(5)** Allocate \$72,000 in State Highway Account/Public Transportation Account funds to City of Tracy for 1 TCI Project.
- 2.6a.(6)** Allocate \$368,000 in State Highway Account/Public Transportation Account funds to San Diego for 1 TCI Project.

- 2.6c.(2)** Allocate \$3,991,000 from the State Highway Account for 1 Local STIP Rail/Transit to the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency.
- 2.6e.** Amend Proposition 116 allocations in Modoc County, Nevada County, and for Sacramento Regional Transit District to deallocate cost savings.
- 2.7** Allocate \$399,000 in FY 1999-00 CAAP funds for 4 projects advanced from the 2000 Aeronautics Program.
- 2.9a.** Replacement Resolution FP-99-63, for \$13,066,500 for 29 minor construction projects. Delete project #5 – Replacement Planting project in San Mateo for \$255,500, for a revised total of \$12,811,000.
- 2.9b.** Replacement Resolution FP-99-64, for \$60,655,000 for 10 major STIP construction projects. Add project #11 – Replacement Planting project in San Mateo for \$256,000 for a revised total allocation of \$60,911,000.
