### RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve Relinquishment Resolutions R-3449, and R-3451 through R-3453.

All superseded highways included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described by the individual summaries.

R-3449 – 4-Mrn-101-PM 16.8/18.3 (Request No. 56015) – 3 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Novato, between 200 feet south of Bolling Drive and Ignacio Boulevard, consisting of frontage road. The City, by cooperative agreement dated March 25, 1997, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. Project accepted on June 1, 1999.

~~R-3450 – 4 SF 101 PM G4.7/5.3 (Request No. 56032) – 1 Segment~~

~~Relinquishes a portion of Route 101 right of way in the City of San Francisco, between Turk Street and Fell Street, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Senate Bill No. 798, Chapter 559 Statutes of 1999 which added Section 72.1 and amended Section 401 of the Streets and Highways Code. ***This item was withdrawn by the Department after release of the CTC Meeting Agenda but prior to meeting material due date.***~~

R-3451 – 5-SB-144-PM 0.0/0.9 (Request No. 5943) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes a portion of Route 144 right of way in the City of Santa Barbara, between State Route 101 and the commencement of Sycamore Canyon Road at the intersection of Montecito, Salinas and Alameda Padre Serra Streets, determined to be in the best interest of the State under terms and conditions as stated in the cooperative agreement dated April 18, 2000. Authorized by Senate Bill No. 557, Chapter 99 Statutes of 1999, which amended Section 354 and amended and repealed Section 444 of the Streets and Highways Code.

R-3452 – 6-Fre-180-PM 58.0/61.4 (Request No. 84071) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Fresno, between State Route 99 and Chestnut Avenue, consisting of highway right of way superseded by highway constructed on new alignment. Project completed on July 14, 1999. The City, by cooperative agreement dated May 23, 2000, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3453 – 11-SD-56-PM 11.6 (Request No. 31094) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Poway, at the intersection of Twin Peaks Road and Community Road, consisting of a park and ride. Project completed in 1991. The City, by resolution dated March 21, 2000, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
