RECOMMENDATION

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve the following Resolution.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION

Resolved, that \$44,867,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 1999, Items 2660-101-0042 and 2660-101-0890 for forty-three (43) Local Regional Transportation Improvement (RIP) projects.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This resolution allocates \$44,867,000 from the State Highway Account and Federal Trust Fund for forty-three (43) local RIP projects listed in the 1998 STIP at an estimated cost of \$72,883,000, including \$28,016,000 from other sources.
