TECHNICAL CHANGES TO PREVIOUSLY APPROVED RESOLUTIONS

RESOLUTION FP 01-05

RECOMMENDATION

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission approve the following Resolution.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION

Resolved, that \$5,845,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2001, Items 2660-101-0042 and 2660-101-0890 for ~~three-two (3) 2~~Local Regional Transportation Improvement (RIP) projects and one (1) Interregional Improvement (IIP) project, **and one (1) Local Regional Transportation Improvement (RIP) project be allocated from Items 2660-301-0042 and 2660-301-0890.**

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This resolution allocates \$5,845,000 in the State Highway Account and Federal Trust funds for three (3) local RIP projects and one (1) Interregional Improvement project (at an estimated cost of \$48,845,000 including \$43,000,000 from other sources.
