TECHNICAL CHANGES TO PREVIOUSLY APPROVED RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION FP-99-88

Technical correction to Resolution FP-99-88, originally approved June 15, 2000, for \$44,867,000 in State and Federal funds for forty-three (43) Local Regional Transportation Improvement (RIP) projects.

For Project #30 (Valley Boulevard Widening Project - PPNO 07-7053) on the attached Book Item Attachment, correct the recipient from Los Angeles County to City of Alhambra and correct the project description from El Monte on Valley Boulevard between Route 710 and Santa Anita Avenue to El Monte on Valley Boulevard between Route 710 and New Avenue.
