### **CAAP ALLOCATIONS - [2000 AERONAUTICS PROGRAM \(2001-02\)](#)**

#### **SUMMARY**

The attached resolution proposes allocating [\\$403,000](#) for [one project](#) from the 2000 Aeronautics Program.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve Resolution [FDOA-2001-6](#), allocation of California Aid to Airports Program (CAAP) funds for Fiscal Year (FY) [2001-02](#).

#### **BACKGROUND**

In March 2000, the Commission adopted the 2000 Aeronautics Program consisting of 74 projects and \$15,976,000. The 2000-01 year of the 2000 Aeronautics Program also includes eleven unallocated prior year projects for \$1,420,000.

The overall cost for the Riverside County Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP) (Project Riv-VAR-01-1) has increased from \$269,000 to \$403,000, a difference of \$134,000. This increase is due to several factors such as the number of airports to be included in the county-wide CLUP (13, plus Chino Airport which is in San Bernardino County but on the border with Riverside County), the updates of the Airport Layout Plans and the existing older airport CLUPs, and the number of jurisdictions which will be involved in the development and approval of the county-wide CLUP. The additional funding is available from a previously programmed but withdrawn 2000 CAAP Project.

**Resolution FDOA-2001-6**

- 1.1 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 21683 of the Public Utilities Code (PUC), the California Transportation Commission (Commission) is authorized to allocate funds for Acquisition and Development (A&D) of airports; and
- 1.2 WHEREAS, on March 30, 2000 the Commission adopted the 2000 three-year Aeronautics Program consisting of 74 projects totaling \$15,976,000, with the 2000-01 year of the 2000 Aeronautics Program containing 11 unallocated prior year projects totaling \$1,420,000; and
- 1.3 WHEREAS, the Department has determined that the projects are feasible, cost effective, in accordance with established policies and standards, and consistent with the priority endorsed by the Commission; and
- 1.4 WHEREAS, all projects recommended for allocation have met the applicable state environmental requirements pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act; and
- 1.5 WHEREAS, each recommended allocation requires a local matching rate of 10 percent of the nonfederal funded portion of the California Aid to Airports Program (CAAP) A&D project as established by the Commission.
- 2.1 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission does hereby allocate \$403,000 and authorizes the Department to extend this offer and enter into a Grant Agreement, consistent with this Resolution, with the following recipients:
