**Ref: Presentation of the Draft FFY 2001-02 Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5310 Elderly and Disabled Transit Program**

## **Summary:**

Staff will present the Draft FFY 2001-02 Section 5310 Elderly and Disabled Transit Program List. Attached are the letter and draft Statewide Prioritized List of Projects as submitted to the Regional Transportation Planning Agencies and Applicants for the Elderly and Disabled Transit Program.

## **Background:**

Each year around August, the Commission adopts the Federal Transit Administration's Section 5310 Elderly and Disabled Transit Program's Program of Projects. Typically, the Commission adopts the Program of Projects down to the 110% funding level to allow flexibility if projects higher up on the list are not completed. This year's estimated Section 5310 funding level is \$8, 023,099. Last year, there was a significant difference in the July draft list and the final list presented in September. Based on the significant changes, the Commission elected to adopt the Program of Projects down to the 100% level of available funding instead of the typical 110% level, and place those projects that had been above the 100% level on the draft July list on a "Prioritized-Standby Project List", which it approved at the October 2000 meeting. The projects listed on the "Prioritized-Standby Project List" were to be funded through funds made available by project deletions or cost savings from previous Section 5310 cycles or were to be funded off the top from funds made available during the FFY 2001-02 cycle. During the past year the Department has been able to identify approximately \$1 million in cost savings or project deletions that will fund ALL the projects that were placed on the "Prioritized-Standby Project List", which were estimated to total \$982,700. The ability to fund all of the projects that were placed on the Prioritized-Standby Project List through cost savings and project deletions will allow the entire estimated amount of \$8,023,099 in FFY 2001-02 funds to fund projects submitted in this year's cycle without taking funds off of the top.

 APPLICANTS FOR ELDERLY AND DISABLED TRANSIT PROGRAM

At the Commission's September 2000 meeting, it approved the FFY 2000-01 Section 5310 Program Prioritized-Standby Project List. This list contained projects that had previously been on the FFY 2000-01 Draft Prioritized List and dropped below the funding level on the Final Program of Projects list. I'm pleased to announce that ALL projects on the approved FFY 2000-01 Section 5310 Program Prioritized-Standby Project List have been fully funded in the amount of \$982,700 by either cost savings or project deletions from previous year's Section 5310 cycles. The ability to fund all the projects off of the Prioritized-Standby Project list will allow the entire estimated amount of \$8,023,099 in FFY 2001-02 funds to fund projects submitted in this year's cycle.

The Statewide Review Committee has reviewed the scored applications for the FFY 2001-02 Elderly and Disabled Transit Program (Title 49 U.S.C. Section 5310) from the Regional Transportation Planning Agencies, and using the program criteria adopted by the California Transportation Commission has developed the draft statewide prioritized project list (copy enclosed). In those instances where there would be a sizable difference in the region's funding level due to differences between the Regional and Statewide Review Committee project scores the regions were, or will be, contacted by Caltrans and the differences thoroughly discussed.

A staff level conference to discuss the draft statewide list has been scheduled for Tuesday, July 24, 2001, at 10:30 a.m. in the Director's Boardroom, Room #2116, which is located on the second floor at 1120 N Street, Sacramento (Caltrans HQ). As a reminder, the purpose of this conference is to discuss the draft statewide prioritized list and hear any appeals on technical issues. Only appeals based on actions that occurred at the statewide level will be considered: the appealing agency, by letter to the State Review Committee, will have to demonstrate, using documentation from its original application, that the Commission's adopted program criteria were incorrectly applied by the statewide committee.

Re: Elderly and Disabled Transit Program

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Approximately \$10 million in funding (including the 20% local share) is expected to be available for the federal FY 2001-02 cycle. Given this estimate, projects with a Statewide Review Committee score of 79 and above on the enclosed list would appear to be candidates for funding depending on the outcome of the July 24, 2001 conference. In accordance with the Commission's adopted procedures and criteria for the Program, the Statewide Review Committee reviewed projects down through a regional score of 75 points (the point score within which the 110% of expected funding level fell). This is done to maintain the size of the project pool while still respecting the time available to the Review Committee and the level of resources available to administer the Program. As we have in the past, Commission staff will also recommend including projects down to a 110% level of available funding on the Commission's final adopted list, to allow for some flexibility if projects higher up on the list are not completed.

If you plan to make a documented technical appeal, you will need to call Caltrans at its toll free number (888) 472-6816 to schedule a speaking time. Each agency will be allowed a maximum of 10 minutes for their appeal(s). You must also put the appeal in writing and mail it to the following address (you may also fax the letter or bring it to the conference):

After the conference, the Statewide Review Committee, if necessary, will revise the list and Commission staff will submit the final statewide prioritized list to the California Transportation Commission. The Commission will hold its mandated public hearing during its August 22-23, 2001, meeting in Sacramento to discuss the prioritized list and overall program policy. The Commission will then adopt the annual Elderly and Disabled Transit Program.
