**DELEGATION OF ALLOCATION AUTHORITY**  
**LOCAL ASSISTANCE ALLOCATIONS FOR RIDESHARE PROJECTS**  
**RESOLUTION G-98-24 ALLOCATIONS**

**BACKGROUND**

On October 28, 1998, the California Transportation Commission delegated to the Department authority to allocate funds by Resolution G-98-24 for Rideshare projects. This authority allows the local agencies to begin work without waiting for the next CTC meeting to receive an allocation.

These Rideshare projects are included in the adopted State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The Department reports allocations on a quarterly basis consistent with Resolution G-98-24.

**SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS**

Pursuant to the authority granted by Resolution G-98-24, since the last report the Department made five separate allocations, totaling \$5,796,000 for five Rideshare projects scheduled for implementation in Fiscal Year 00-01. A list of the allocations is attached.
