RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTION

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve Relinquishment Resolutions R-3494 - R3496.

All superseded highways included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described by the individual summaries.

R-3494 – 05-SLO-41-PM 16.0/18.4 (Request No. 7243) – 2 Segments

Amends Relinquishment R-3488, adopted by the California Transportation Commission on June 6, 2001, which contained an incorrect reference to the map recording information. Relinquishes right of way in the City of Atascadero, from Morro Road to the easterly city limit, consisting of highway right of way superseded by highway constructed on new alignment. Project completed on December 21, 2000. The City by cooperative agreement dated January 23, 2001, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3495 – 06-Fre-168-PM R3.4/R4.0 (Request No. 84391) – 4 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Fresno, from Cedar Avenue to Chestnut Avenue, consisting of highway right of way superseded by highway constructed on new alignment and relocated or reconstructed city streets. The City by cooperative agreement dated April 25, 2000, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. Project accepted on July 21, 2000. The City by letter dated July 11, 2001, corrected an omission to the cooperative agreement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3496 – 07-LA-91-PM 0.2/2.5 (Request No. 1216A) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes a portion of Route 91 right of way in the City of Redondo Beach, from Harper Avenue to Hawthorne Boulevard, under terms and conditions as stated in the cooperative agreement dated February 20, 2001, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 1007, Statutes of 1999, which added Section 391.3 to the Streets and Highways Code.
