APPROVAL OF PROJECT FOR FUTURE CONSIDERATION OF FUNDING
ROUTE 70 IN PLUMAS COUNTY

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

The attached resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Negative Declaration has been completed:

- Route 70 in Plumas County- Rehabilitate the highway between Purdy Lane and Clough Street in Quincy.

The project is programmed in the 2000 State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) for construction in the 2001/02 fiscal year at \$11.8 million (\$9.7 million capital funds and \$2.1 million support funds). The current project estimate is \$11.7 million (capital and support costs).


The Negative Declaration and supporting Initial Study has been transmitted to Commission staff.

The Department has approved the project for construction. This approval and the resulting filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.


RECOMMENDATION
