**DELEGATION OF ALLOCATION AUTHORITY**  
**LOCAL ASSISTANCE ALLOCATIONS FOR PROJECT DEVELOPMENT COMPONENTS**  
**OF LOCAL GRANT PROJECTS**  
**RESOLUTION G-01-03 ALLOCATIONS**

**BACKGROUND**

On February 22, 2001, the California Transportation Commission (Commission) delegated to the Department of Transportation (Department) authority to allocate funds under Resolution G-01-03 for Project Development Components of Local Grant projects. In addition, the Commission delegated to the Department authority to advance the allocation by two years with the approval of the responsible regional agency. This authority allows the local agencies to begin work without waiting for the next Commission meeting to receive an allocation. The Department reports allocations on a monthly basis consistent with Resolution G-01-03.

**SUMMARY**

The Department made five (5) allocations totaling \$440,000 for project development components of five (5) local grant projects. The Department also made one (1) allocation of \$100,000 for a project development component of the Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) San Francisco Airport (SFO) Bikeway Extension in June 2001. No allocations were made subject to the provisions of AB 872, with reimbursement effective dates up to 12 months before the allocation dates. Pursuant to the authority for advancing the allocation by two years, no advance allocations were made during this report period for projects or project components scheduled for implementation in FY 2002-2003 or 2003-2004.

As of this report, a total of \$4,891,000 was allocated this fiscal year. This amount includes \$840,000 for projects programmed in FY 2001-2002; \$3,803,000 for a project programmed in FY 1999-2000 that received a time extension; and \$248,000 for a project programmed in FY 2000-2001 that also received a time extension. (The BART/SFO Bikeway Extension project allocation of \$100,000 was made in FY 2000-2001 and was not included in the August 2001 report to the Commission.) The attached lists provide the details of each allocation.
