RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve Relinquishment Resolution R-3466.

The local agency will be accepting a lump sum payment to satisfy the States obligation to place the highway in a state of good repair. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described by the individual summary.

R-3466 – 12-Ora-22-PM 3.6/3.9 (Request No. 22895-R) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Stanton, between Beach Boulevard (SR 39) and Fern Street, consisting of highway right of way superseded by highway constructed on new alignment. Project constructed in the mid 1960's. The City by cooperative agreement dated August 17, 2000, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
