FINANCIAL RESOLUTION

Resolved, that \$19,069,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2001, Items 2660-101-0042 and 2660-101-0890 for one (1) Local Interregional Transportation Improvement (IIP) project.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This resolution allocates \$19,069,000 in the State Highway Account and Federal Trust funds for one (1) local IIP project listed in the 2000 STIP at an estimated cost of \$19,069,000 including \$37,641,000 from other sources.
