RESCINDING RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY

The Department of Transportation (the Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission adopt Rescinding Resolution of Necessity CR-124. In accordance with Statutory requirements, the owner has been advised that the Department is requesting rescission of Resolution C-18034 at this time.

CR-124 - Sorrento Business Complex, A Limited Partnership
11-SD-5-KP 53.7- Parcel 26984-1,2 – E.A. 030149 (Freeway) Rescinds Resolution of Necessity C-18034, adopted March 30, 2000, which authorized condemnation of a temporary easement for highway construction, a permanent easement for access, maintenance, and footing purposes.

Resolution C-18034 is rescinded because the Department was not able to file the lawsuit within the six-month time frame required by Section 1245.260 of the Code of Civil Procedure due to project design requirement changes. Additional interest (temporary easement for highway construction) is required.
