**FINANCIAL RESOLUTION**

Resolved, that \$12,513,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2000, Items 2660-101-0042 and 2660-101-0890 for four (4) Local Regional Transportation Improvement (RIP) projects.

**SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS**

This resolution allocates \$12,513,000 in the State Highway Account and Federal Trust funds for four (4) local RIP projects listed in the 1998 STIP at an estimated cost of \$13,111,000, including \$598,000 from other sources.
