RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission approve Relinquishment Resolutions R-3504 - R-3505.

All superseded highways included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described by the individual summaries.

R-3504 – 04-CC-4-PM R15.3 (Request No. 56046) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Concord, at Port Chicago Highway, consisting of reconstructed city street. The City by resolution dated April 10, 2001, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

R-3505 – 07-Ven-126-PM 13.5 (Request No. 1103) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Santa Paula, at Hallock Drive, consisting of frontage roads. The City by cooperative agreement dated July 6, 1999, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
