**DELEGATION OF ALLOCATION AUTHORITY**  
**LOCAL ASSISTANCE ALLOCATIONS FOR**  
**LOCAL STREET AND ROAD PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECTS**  
**RESOLUTION G-01-04 ALLOCATIONS**

**BACKGROUND**

On February 22, 2001, the California Transportation Commission (Commission) delegated to the Department of Transportation (Department) authority to allocate funds by Resolution G-01-04 for Local Streets and Roads Pavement Rehabilitation projects. In addition, the Commission delegated to the Department authority to advance the allocation by two years with the approval of the responsible regional agency. This authority allows the local agencies to begin work without waiting for the next Commission meeting to receive an allocation.

These Local Streets and Roads Pavement Rehabilitation projects are included in the adopted State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The Department reports allocations on a monthly basis consistent with Resolution G-01-04.

**SUMMARY**

Pursuant to the authority granted by Resolution G-01-04, the Department made 2 separate allocations totaling \$15,000, for 2 Local Streets and Roads Pavement Rehabilitation projects. No allocations were made subject to the provisions of AB 872, with reimbursement effective dates up to 12 months prior to the allocation dates.

The 2 allocations, for 2 projects totaling \$15,000, were made for projects programmed in Fiscal Year (FY) 2001-2002. Pursuant to the authority for advancing the allocation by two years, no allocations were made during this report period for projects or project components scheduled for implementation in FY 2002-2003. There were no advances for projects programmed in FY 2003-2004. The attached list provides details of the allocations.

As of this report, \$7,875,000 has been allocated this FY. Of this amount, \$6,415,000 is for projects programmed for the FY 2001-2002. Another \$1,298,000 is for advanced allocations from FY 2002-2003 and \$162,000 is for allocations made for projects extended from FY 1999-2000.
