Ref: Live Oak Canyon Interchange Project (San Bernardino County) Future Consideration of Funding to Construct a Concrete Bridge Across Wilson Creek Channel and Extend 14th Street Easterly to Oak Glen Road in the City of Yucaipa - (Notice of Determination) (TCRP #59) Resolution E-02-28

Issue:

Should the California Transportation Commission (Commission) adopt the attached resolution to approve future consideration of funding to construct a concrete bridge across Wilson Creek Channel and extend 14th Street easterly to Oak Glen Road in the City of Yucaipa in San Bernardino County?

Recommendation:

The Commission staff recommends that the Commission, as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-02-28. As a responsible agency, the Commission must approve this resolution prior to allocating funds for capital purposes on the proposed project.

Background:

This resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Mitigated Negative Declaration under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) has been completed:

- Live Oak Canyon Interchange Project - (San Bernardino County) - Construct a concrete bridge across Wilson Creek Channel and extend 14th Street easterly to Oak Glen Road in the City of Yucaipa.

The current total estimate for the project is \$11,000,000, and will be totally funded from the Traffic Congestion Relief Program (TCRP). The project is included in the Route 10-Live Oak Canyon Interchange in the City of Yucaipa, San Bernardino County (TCRP Project #59) to fund environmental, planning, specifications and estimates, utility relocation, right-of-way and construction.

The City of Yucaipa has approved a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the 14th Street/Wilson Creek Crossing. The Mitigated Negative Declaration and supporting Initial Study has been transmitted to Commission staff. The Commission's approval and the resulting filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.
