RESOLUTION FP-01-12

RECOMMENDATION

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the following Resolution.

FINANCIAL RESOLUTION

Resolved, that \$12,900,000 be allocated from the Budget Acts of 2000 and 2001, Items 2660-101-0042 and 2660-101-0890 for five (5) Local Regional Transportation Improvement (RIP) projects.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This resolution allocates \$12,900,000 in the State Highway Account and Federal Trust funds for five (5) local RIP projects listed in the 2000 STIP at an estimated cost of \$19,739,000, including \$6,839,000 from other sources.
