Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

ISSUE:

The collateral facilities included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishment a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the summary.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends the Commission approve the following six Relinquishment Resolutions:

Resolution No. R-3542 – 08-SBd-15,30-PM 9.2/9.4 (Request No. 432S) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Rancho Cucamonga, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city street. The City by freeway agreement dated March 4, 1998, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State and by resolution dated March 5, 2003, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3543 – 08-SBd-30-PM 9.4/9.6 (Request No. 440S) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Rancho Cucamonga, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city street. The City by freeway agreement dated November 20, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State and by resolution dated March 5, 2003, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3544 – 08-SBd-30-PM 12.7/15.0 (Request No. 439S) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Fontana, consisting of highway right of way superseded by highway constructed on new alignment, reconstructed and relocated city street and a cul-de-sac. The City by freeway agreement dated November 14, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired March 2, 2003, without exception.

Resolution No. R-3545 – 08-SBd-30,210-PM 4.0/9.4 (Request No. 437S) – 5 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Rancho Cucamonga, consisting of highway right of way superseded by highway constructed on new alignment, reconstructed and relocated city street, cul-de-sacs and a non-motorized transportation facility, namely a pedestrian walkway. The City by freeway agreement dated November 20, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State and by resolution dated March 5, 2003, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3546 – 08-SBd-30,210-PM 9.2/12.6 (Request No. 431S) – 6 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Fontana, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city street, frontage roads and cul-de-sacs. The City by freeway agreements dated March 1, 1994 and November 14, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired March 2, 2003, without exception.

Resolution No. R-3547 – 08-SBd-66-PM 4.1/10.9 (Request No. 435S) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes a portion of Route 66 right of way in the City of Rancho Cucamonga, between Grove Avenue and East Avenue, under terms and conditions as stated in the relinquishment cooperative agreement dated December 4, 2002, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 248, Statutes of 2002, which amended Section 366 of the Streets and Highways Code.
