Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

## **ISSUE:**

The collateral facilities included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation recommends the Commission approve the following Relinquishment Resolutions:

### Resolution No. R-3558 – 07-LA-105-PM 4.7 (Request No. 1171B) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Hawthorne, between Crenshaw Boulevard and Haas Boulevard, consisting of reconstructed city street and a cul-de-sac. The City, by freeway agreement dated October 16, 1982, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired April 28, 1996, without exception.

### Resolution No. R-3559 – 08-Riv-215-PM 27.4/34.0 (Request No. 441R) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Perris, consisting of relocated and reconstructed city streets. The City annexed an area containing relocated and reconstructed city street at the intersection of Morgan Street and Nevada Avenue that the County of Riverside, by freeway agreement dated August 21, 1979, had agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The City, by freeway agreement dated June 13, 1988, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State to relocated and reconstructed city street at Oleander Avenue. The 90-day notice period expired September 10, 2003, without exception.
