Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

## **ISSUE:**

The collateral facilities included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation recommends the Commission approve the following Relinquishment Resolutions:

### Resolution No. R-3569 – 03-Nev-89-KP 1.4 (Request No. 34081-X) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the Town of Truckee, along the old alignment of State Route 89, 1.4 kilometers north of State Route 80, consisting of a portion of superseded state highway right of way that is appurtenant to a previously relinquished superseded highway and was inadvertently omitted from said relinquishment. The Town, by cooperative agreement dated March 4, 1999, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

### Resolution No. R-3570 – 08-SBd-62-PM 8.7/14.9 (Request No. 443S) – 7 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the Town of Yucca Valley, from Fairway Drive to Ronald Drive, consisting of frontage roads. The Town, by relinquishment cooperative agreement dated December 18, 2003, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3571 – 08-SBd-66-PM 10.9/17.1 (Request No. 434S) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes a portion of Route 66 right of way in the City of Fontana, lying within the City limits and within the unincorporated sphere of influence of the City, under terms and conditions as stated in the relinquishment cooperative agreement dated May 6, 2003, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 251, Statutes of 2002, which amended Section 366 of the Streets and Highways Code.

Resolution No. R-3572 – 11-SD-125-PM 18.1/18.5 (Request No. R27209-B) – 3 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of El Cajon, between Tahoe Street and Freeborn Way, consisting of relocated and reconstructed city street, frontage road and cul-de-sacs. The City, by freeway agreement dated October 9, 2001, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired January 20, 2004, without exception.

Resolution No. R-3573 – 11-SD-125-PM 18.8 (Request No. R27209-C) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of El Cajon, at Navajo Road, consisting of relocated and reconstructed city street. The City, by freeway agreement dated October 9, 2001, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired January 20, 2004, without exception.

Resolution No. R-3574 – 11-SD-125-PM 19.2 & 19.7 (Request No. R27209-A) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of El Cajon, at Katherine Street and on Sladon Drive south of Gibbons Street, consisting of relocated and reconstructed city street, frontage road and cul-de-sacs. The City, by freeway agreements dated September 3, 1965 and October 9, 2001, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired January 20, 2004, without exception.
