## **ISSUE:**

The attached resolution proposes to approve, for future consideration of funding, the following project for which a Negative Declaration has been completed:

- Route 219 in Stanislaus County – Widen to four lanes near Salida.

The environmental document for this project was submitted previously to the Commission on June 28, 2002, and was approved for funding on July 10, 2002. Subsequent legal action resulted in additions to the environmental document, which is again being submitted for Commission action. This project is fully funded in the 2002 STIP with a total cost of \$33,478,000.

The Department of Transportation (Department) has approved the project for construction. This approval and the filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department recommends that the California Transportation Commission, as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-04-16.

#### **Resolution E-04-16**


