## **ISSUE:**

The attached resolution proposes to approve, for future consideration of funding, the following project for which a Negative Declaration has been completed:

- Montgomery Way or Hess Road in Tehama County – Relocate the Red Bluff Maintenance Station in Red Bluff.

This project is fully funded in the 2004 State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) for construction in FY 2005-06. The total estimated project cost is \$9,898,000.

The Department of Transportation (Department) has approved the project for construction. This approval and the filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department recommends that the California Transportation Commission, as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-04-23.
