Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

## **ISSUE:**

The collateral facilities included in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation recommends the Commission approve the following three Relinquishment Resolutions:

### Resolution No. R-3583 – 5-SLO-101-PM 0.6/0.8 (Request No. 9551) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the County of San Luis Obispo, along Hutton Road, between Cuyama Lane and 0.2 mile south of Cuyama Lane, consisting of frontage road. The County, by cooperative agreement, dated June 8, 2004, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

### Resolution No. R-3584 – 5-SCr-152-KP T2.9/T3.7 (Request No. 8427) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Watsonville, along Longview Drive, from 131 meters west of Pennsylvania Drive to 164 meters east of Auto Center Drive, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city streets and frontage roads. The City, by cooperative agreement, dated April 27, 2004, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3585 – 12-Ora-5-PM 39.1/39.2 (Request No. R120014) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Anaheim, at Manchester Court and Lincoln Avenue, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city street and frontage road. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992 and by amendment to freeway agreement dated July 9, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The City by resolution dated August 3, 2004, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
