Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

ISSUE:

The facilities in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are safe and drivable or have been maintained in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation recommends the Commission approve the following Relinquishment Resolutions:

Resolution No. R-3593 – 4-Sol-37-KP 12.9 (Request No. 56070) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Vallejo, on Wilson Avenue at Lighthouse Drive, consisting of a reconstructed city street. The City, by resolution dated September 21, 2004, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3594 – 6-Fre-180-KP R89.0/R91.0 (Request No. 85224) – 6 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Fresno, between the Hughes/West Diagonal and State Route 99, consisting of superseded highway right of way, reconstructed and relocated city streets and cul-de-sacs. The City, by cooperative agreement dated September 28, 2004, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3595 – 6-Ker-14-KP 29.9/30.5 (Request No. 213) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the County of Kern, at the southwest quadrant of State Route 14/58 interchange, consisting of frontage road. The County, by cooperative agreement, dated October 8, 2002, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3596 – 8-Riv-79-PM 2.5/4.5 & 15.6/19.4 (Request No. 445R) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes a portion of Route 79 right of way in the City of Temecula, under terms and conditions as stated in the cooperative agreement dated November 9, 2004, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 386, Statutes of 2004, which amended Section 379 of the Streets and Highways Code.

Resolution No. R-3597 – 12-Ora-1-PM 0.96/4.63 (Request No. R120005) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes a portion of Route 1 right of way in the City of Dana Point, from the west edge of the San Juan Creek Bridge to the northerly City limit near Eastline Road, under terms and conditions as stated in the cooperative agreement dated August 3, 2004, determined to be in the best interest of the State. Authorized by Chapter 757, Statutes of 2001, which amended Section 301 of the Streets and Highways Code.

Resolution No. R-3598 – 12-Ora-5-PM 39.1/39.2 (Request No. R120014) – 1 Segment

Amends Resolution R-3585, adopted by the California Transportation Commission on September 15, 2004, which contained an incorrect reference to the map recording information. Relinquishes right of way in the City of Anaheim, at Manchester Court and Lincoln Avenue, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city street and frontage road. The City, by freeway agreement dated November 9, 1992 and by amendment to freeway agreement dated July 9, 1996, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The City by resolution dated August 3, 2004, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3599 – 12-Ora-73-PM 4.8/5.6 (Request No. R120003) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the City of Newport Beach, along Bristol Street and North Bristol Street, from Jamboree Road to Irwin Avenue/Campus Drive, consisting of frontage roads. The City, by cooperative agreement dated May 20, 2004, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3600 – 12-Ora-73-PM 5.6/5.9 (Request No. R120002) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the County of Orange, along Bristol Street and North Bristol Street, consisting of frontage roads. The County, by cooperative agreement dated July 27, 2004, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
