RESOLUTION E-05-04**

ISSUE:

The attached resolution proposes to approve for future consideration of funding the following project for which a Negative Declaration has been completed:

- 5900 Folsom Boulevard in Sacramento County – Building safety corrections in Sacramento.

The project would be constructed in four phases. Phases 1, 2 and 3 are fully funded in the 2004 State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) for a total of \$15,000,000. These phases will be constructed in successive fiscal years, as follows: Phase 1 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2004-05, Phase 2 in FY 2005-06, and Phase 3 in FY 2006-07. Phase 4 is a candidate for the 2006 SHOPP, estimated at \$5,000,000, for construction in FY 2007-08. The total estimated project cost is \$20,000,000.

A copy of the Negative Declaration has been provided to California Transportation Commission (Commission) staff. The Department of Transportation (Department) has approved the project for construction. This approval and the filing of the Notice of Determination with the Office of Planning and Research will satisfy the environmental requirements for this stage of the project planning process.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department recommends that the Commission, as a responsible agency, approve the attached Resolution E-05-04.
