Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTION**

ISSUE:

The facilities in the relinquishment resolutions summarized below are safe and drivable or have been maintained in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation recommends the Commission approve the following Relinquishment Resolution:

Resolution No. R-3605 – 8-SBd-58-PM 36.1/37.0 & 39.3/39.4 (Request No. 404S) – 2 Segments
Relinquishes right of way in the City of Barstow, between Irwin Road and State Route 15, consisting of superseded highway right of way. The City, by relinquishment cooperative agreement dated January 7, 2005, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
