The Modoc County Transportation Commission (Modoc CTC) is requesting the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve this State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) amendment. This amendment was noticed and discussed at the April 2005 Commission meeting, and no further action is required. The Commission placed the Action Item on the consent calendar for the May 2005 Commission meeting.

The City of Alturas and Modoc CTC propose to make the following changes to their Regional Improvement Program (RIP) Transportation Enhancement (TE) Reserve (PPNO 3210): advance and reprogram \$723,000 in the TE Reserve (PPNO 3210) from FY 2008-09 to FY 2005-06; revise the project description from TE Reserve to Alturas Scenic Beautification; and program an additional \$277,000 from Modoc County's unprogrammed share to FY 2005-06 to fully fund the new Alturas Scenic Beautification project for a total of \$1,000,000, including \$965,000 for Construction (CON), \$25,000 for Design (PS&E), and \$10,000 for CON Support.

RECOMMENDATION

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends approval.

BACKGROUND

In the 2004 STIP programming cycle, Modoc CTC's Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) included \$723,000 of RIP funds programmed in a TE Reserve. The Commission, under Resolution G-04-07, approved the RTIP on August 5, 2004.

This amendment proposes to advance and reprogram \$723,000 of Modoc County's RIP TE Reserve funds from FY 2008-09 to FY 2005-06 and supplement that amount with an additional \$277,000 in RIP TE funds, for a total of \$1,000,000, to fully fund the new Alturas Scenic Beautification project (PPNO 3210), formerly Modoc County's TE Reserve.

The TE project provides street and pedestrian sidewalk lighting along both sides of Main Street in the City of Alturas. The lighting will extend from the south end of town, near Glen Street, north for approximately one mile to the intersection of Route 395 and Route 299. The lights will be placed on the existing sidewalk just outside the clear recovery zone and spaced to meet the illumination specifications set forth by the City of Alturas. The purpose of this project is to enhance and improve the historic significance of the downtown district.

The Department has a State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) project (PPNO 0059G) in the same location as the TE project, which will be ready for allocation in May. The SHOPP work includes the rehabilitation of the existing pavement in downtown Alturas, replacement of portions of curb, gutter and sidewalk, and relocation of existing lights outside the clear recovery zone. Additionally, The SHOPP project includes drainage improvements at several intersections, extending cattle crossings, and roadway excavations to improve site distance.

The Department, in partnership with Modoc County, is proposing to combine this SHOPP project with the Alturas Scenic Beautification TE project (PPNO 3210). By combining these projects, cost savings have been estimated at \$240,000 on Environmental, Right-of-Way Support, as well as PS&E and will benefit both the City of Alturas and the Department. The savings is due to the fact that the scope of the TE project is entirely within the limits of the SHOPP project. Furthermore, the SHOPP project has to be advertised as soon as possible to take advantage of the environmental construction window. If the TE project is not voted, the SHOPP project would need to be delayed. Both projects impact downtown local businesses but will be minimized if construction is performed simultaneously. Commitments have been made with local businesses, governing bodies and citizens that construction would begin in 2005. If the SHOPP project and the TE project are not combined, additional resources would be needed and inefficiencies created. Moreover, it would cause significant disruption to the City's historic downtown district.


