Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

ISSUE:

The facilities in the relinquishment resolution summarized below are safe and drivable or have been maintained in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishment a minimum of 90 days prior to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described below.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation recommends the Commission approve the following Relinquishment Resolution:

Resolution No. R-3606 – 4-Ala-112-PM 0.0/0.5 (Request No. 40380-2) – 2 Segments
Relinquishes right of way in the City of San Leandro, at Carden Street, consisting of reconstructed and relocated city streets and service roads. The City, by agreement dated October 16, 1978, and amendment to agreement dated January 2, 1979, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The City by letter dated July 13, 2004, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
