Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

## **ISSUE:**

The facilities in the relinquishment resolution summarized below are safe and drivable or have been maintained in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described below.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation recommends the Commission approve the following Relinquishment Resolution:

Resolution No. R-3609 – 11-SD-15-KP 0.8/2.9 (Request No. R31095) – 3 Segments  
Relinquishes right of way in the City of San Diego, along 36<sup>th</sup> Street, between Imperial Avenue and K Street, consisting of a reconstructed and relocated city street. The City, by cooperative agreement dated February 28, 2005, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
