Ref: **INFORMATIONAL REPORT – FIVE DELEGATED SHOPP MINOR PROJECTS  
ALLOCATED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER RESOLUTION G-05-05**

Pursuant to the authority granted by Resolution G-05-05, the Department of Transportation (Department) sub-allocated \$2,591,000 for five (5) State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Minor projects, described on the attached list.

As of this report, \$33,066,000 for 65 SHOPP Minor projects has been allocated to date in FY 2005-06.

## **BACKGROUND:**

On July 14, 2005, the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approved Resolution G-05-05, delegating to the Department authority to allocate funds for Minor projects. Concurrently, the funding and project listing was approved by the Commission under Resolution FM-05-03. This authority accelerates project construction.

The Department has complied with the National Environmental Policy Act and the California Environmental Quality Act requirements in preparing these projects.
