FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:



Project Location

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project is in San Bernardino County on Route 40. The scope of work includes replacement of Fenner Overhead Left and Right bridge and rehabilitating bridge approach/departure slabs and grinding of existing roadway.

FUNDING STATUS

The project was programmed in the 2002 State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) for \$6,060,000 for construction in FY 2002-03. The project was allocated \$6,060,000 in May 2003. An amount of \$89,000 was approved through G12 to award the contract in September 2003. A second G12 was processed in June 2005 for \$713,000 to account for earth work shortages. An additional \$1,549,000 in supplemental funds is now needed to complete construction.

REASONS FOR COST INCREASE

The majority of the cost increase for this project is due to:

- Shutdown of all construction activities between October and December in both 2004 and 2005, imposed by the railroad, to permit additional train traffic to proceed. Because a final railroad agreement had not been executed prior to award, this requirement had not been incorporated into the contract.
- Girder redesign was required to correct the span length and to adjust post-tensioning ducts to avoid conflict with reinforcing steel. The redesign caused an additional three month delay due to missing the fabrication window.

Both setbacks resulted in an overall delay of construction activities of one year and three months. These delays increased the overall cost of the operation due to inefficiencies for the contractor with equipment and crews standing idle. Supplemental funds of \$1,549,000 are being requested in order to complete construction.

FUNDING OPTIONS

OPTION A: Approve this request, as presented above, for \$1,549,000 to allow construction on this safety project to be completed.

OPTION B: Deny this request and direct the Department to downscope the project to remain within the allocated amount. The Department considered this option and determined that reducing the scope of work on this project and executing another project to complete the deleted work later, would result in greater costs and more disruption to the traveling public and the railroad.

RECOMMENDED OPTION

The Department recommends that this request for \$1,549,000, as presented in Option A above, be approved to allow construction to be completed.
