Attached is a list of nine (9) State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) projects totaling \$25,529,000.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends that the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the following resolution allocating \$5,158,000 for Project #7 – Maacama Creek and Redwood Creek Bridges (EA 209901), described on the attached vote list.

The Department further recommends that the Commission defer the allocation request for the remaining projects until such time as funding is made available after awarding higher priority projects.

## **FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved, that \$5,158,000 be allocated from the Budget Act 2004, Budget Act Item 2660-302-0042, for one (1) SHOPP project, as described on the attached vote list.
