ISSUE:

Attached is a Vote List for one Traffic Congestion Relief Program (TCRP) project allocation request for \$14,000,000 in new TCRP funds to reimburse a previously approved AB 1335 Letter of No Prejudice (LONP) for the project identified.

RECOMMENDATION:

The California Department of Transportation (Department) recommends approval.

BACKGROUND:

The Governor's FY 2005-06 Budget Proposal includes the transfer of Proposition 42 funding. The project phase approved for the LONP reimbursement request has been completed in accordance with Resolution G-03-12, Guidelines for Letter of No Prejudice, Traffic Congestion Relief Program.
