The City of Ripon (City) is requesting that this proposed State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) amendment be noticed at the March 2006 California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting and be considered for approval in April 2006. This Notice is an informational item allowing the Commission to review the proposal, comment and/or ask questions prior to taking formal action in April 2006 or later.

The City proposes to reprogram \$1,925,000 of FY 2005-06 Regional Improvement Program (RIP) Construction from the South Frontage Road and Wilma Overcrossing project (PPNO 3K48) to FY 2005-06 Construction on the Main Street and Stockton Avenue Rehabilitation and Widening project (PPNO 3K47). This amendment also proposes to increase the project scope for the Main Street and Stockton Avenue Rehabilitation project. San Joaquin Council of Governments (SJCOG) concurs with this request.

RECOMMENDATION

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the proposed STIP amendment be approved at the April 2006 Commission meeting.

BACKGROUND

The South Frontage Road and Wilma Overcrossing project (PPNO 3K48) is currently programmed for \$1,925,000 of FY 2005-06 RIP Construction (CON). The project will construct a new roadway between Stockton Avenue and Pine Street and between Maple Avenue and Canal Boulevard in the City. This project has been delivered with local funds. The City proposes to reprogram \$1,925,000 from the South Frontage Road and Wilma Overcrossing project to the Main Street and Stockton Avenue Rehabilitation and Widening project for Construction in FY 2005-06.

The Main Street and Stockton Avenue Rehabilitation and Widening project (PPNO 3K47) is currently programmed for \$1,102,000 of FY 2005-06 RIP CON. The project will rehabilitate Main Street from Acacia Avenue to Wilma Avenue and Stockton Avenue from Main Street to 2nd Street in the City. The City proposes to increase the scope of the project with the inclusion of a road widening and a safety component. The proposed road widening will be an expansion of Stockton Avenue to include the road widening and sidewalk improvements from 2nd Street to just south of 5th Street. The proposed safety component will add traffic signal synchronization and median island replacement to alleviate existing traffic safety concerns on Main Street from Wilma Avenue to Jack Tone Road. The increase in scope is due to utility conflicts with existing power poles. The City proposes to fund the increase with the \$1,925,000 from the South Frontage Road and Wilma Overcrossing project.

RESOLUTION

Resolved, that the California Transportation Commission revise the 2004 State Transportation Improvement Program at the end of the 30-day notice period, as follows:


