Ref: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the Relinquishment Resolutions described below.

## **ISSUE:**

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below is not essential to the proper functioning of the State highway system and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolution in the county where the facility is located, all right, title and interest of the State in and to the facility to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agency identified in the summary. Consequently, the facility is safe and drivable, or has been maintained in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the California Transportation Commission (Commission) meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

Resolution No. R-3634 – 4-Son-101-PM 15.4 (Request No. 56073) – 1 Segment  
Relinquishes right of way in the County of Sonoma, at Santa Rosa Avenue and Roberts Lake Road, consisting of superseded highway right of way. The County, by letter dated November 2, 2004, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired February 26, 2006, without exception.

Resolution No. R-3635 – 4-Son-101-PM 53.9/56.2 (Request No. 40439) – 1 Segment  
Relinquishes right of way in the County of Sonoma, between the Preston Overhead and the Mendocino County Line, consisting of superseded highway right of way. The County, by letter dated February 15, 2006, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
