## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the following resolution, allocating \$4,130,000 for two State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Transportation Enhancement (TE) projects.

## **ISSUE:**

The attached list describes two locally-administered STIP TE projects totaling \$4,130,000, plus \$610,000 from other sources. The agencies for these projects are ready to proceed and are requesting an allocation at this time.

## **FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved, that \$4,130,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2006, Budget Act Items 2660-101-0042 and 2660-101-0890, for two locally-administered STIP projects, as described on the attached vote list.
