Subject: **RELINQUISHMENT RESOLUTIONS**

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the relinquishment resolutions, summarized below, that will transfer highway facilities no longer needed for the State Highway System to the local agency identified in the summary.

ISSUE:

It has been determined that each facility in the specific relinquishment resolutions summarized below are not essential to the proper functioning of the State highway system and may be disposed of by relinquishment. Upon the recording of the approved relinquishment resolution in the county where the facility is located, all right, title and interest of the State in and to the facility to be relinquished will be transferred to the local agency identified in the summary. Consequently, the facility is safe and drivable, or has been maintained in a state of good repair. The local authorities have been advised of the pending relinquishments a minimum of 90 days prior to the Commission meeting for both superseded highways and collateral facilities pursuant to Section 73 of the Streets and Highways Code. Any exceptions or unusual circumstances are described in the individual summaries.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution No. R-3660 – 3-Yol-505-PM 9.5
(Request No. 34392-X) – 1 Segment

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Yolo, at County Road 24, consisting of reconstructed and relocated county roads and frontage roads. The County, by freeway agreements dated March 3, 1958, September 26, 1966, and by a supplemental freeway agreement dated August 18, 1975, agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State. The 90-day notice period expired March 22, 2007, without exception.

Resolution No. R-3661 – 4-SCI-101-PM R22.9

(Request No. 56077) – 2 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Santa Clara, consisting of reconstructed and relocated county roads. The County, by resolution dated November 14, 2006, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.

Resolution No. R-3662 – 10-Cal-26-PM 33.5/33.8

(Request No. 14117) – 3 Segments

Relinquishes right of way in the county of Calaveras, consisting of reconstructed and relocated county roads. The County, by resolution dated November 6, 2006, waived the 90-day notice requirement and agreed to accept title upon relinquishment by the State.
