RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve a technical correction to Resolution FP-06-64, originally approved February 1, 2007, for \$160,000 for two locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) projects.

ISSUE:

A technical correction is needed for Project #2 – Scenic Viewshed Acquisition (PPNO 05-1827A) to correct the project recipient. The lead agency for this project should be Monterey County, not Monterey County Park District.
