## **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the California Transportation Commission (Commission) approve the following resolution, allocating \$6,916,000 for three locally-administered State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) projects.

## **ISSUE:**

The attached vote list describes three locally-administered STIP Rail/Transit projects totaling \$6,916,000. The agencies for these projects are ready to proceed and are requesting an allocation at this time.

## **FINANCIAL RESOLUTION:**

Resolved, that \$6,916,000 be allocated from the Budget Act of 2006, Budget Act Item 2660-101-0046, for three locally-administered STIP Rail/Transit projects, as described on the attached vote list.
