Subject: **INFORMATIONAL REPORT - SEISMIC RETROFIT PROJECT PHASE 2 ALLOCATION**

## **SUMMARY:**

Pursuant to the authority granted by Resolution G-11, Seismic Retrofit Bond funds totaling \$3,500,000 have been allocated for one Seismic Retrofit Phase 2 project described below.

Project #1. In Alameda County, on Route 580 at the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge Distribution Structure in Oakland. Initial project was for the seismic retrofit of 17 bents (18 columns) including the retrofit of the superstructure, bent caps, columns and foundations. This supplemental adds Bent BM-20 (Bridge # 33-0061) seismic retrofit that was initially split from the project due to right of way delays. The supplemental also covers unanticipated hazardous waste remediation and dewatering.

## **BACKGROUND:**

On March 30, 1994, the California Transportation Commission (Commission) delegated to the Department of Transportation (Department) authority to allocate funds by Resolution G-11, as amended by Resolution G-00-11, for seismic retrofit projects. This authority allows the Department to begin work without waiting for the next Commission meeting to receive an allocation.

This project is part of the legislatively mandated Bridge Seismic Retrofit Program (SB131), approved by the Governor's Office on March 15, 1994.
